Responsibilities of Authors

Authors submitting manuscripts to NeelLex should:

- Submit only original and unpublished work.
- Ensure all co-authors have approved the manuscript.
- Properly acknowledge all sources.
- Obtain permission for copyrighted material where required.
- Report research findings honestly and accurately.
- Disclose conflicts of interest.
- Follow applicable ethical guidelines for research involving humans or animals.
- Cooperate with editors during the review and publication process.

Responsibilities of Editors

Editors are expected to:

- Evaluate submissions fairly and objectively.
- Maintain confidentiality throughout the editorial process.
- Avoid conflicts of interest.
- Make editorial decisions based solely on academic merit.
- Ensure ethical standards are maintained.
- Take appropriate action in cases of suspected misconduct.

Responsibilities of Reviewers

Reviewers should:

- Treat manuscripts as confidential documents.
- Provide constructive, objective, and unbiased feedback.
- Identify relevant published work not cited.
- Report suspected ethical concerns.
- Complete reviews within agreed timelines.
- Avoid reviewing manuscripts where conflicts of interest exist.

Research Integrity

NeelLex expects all published work to demonstrate:

- Scientific accuracy
- Methodological transparency
- Proper documentation
- Reproducibility where applicable
- Ethical data collection and reporting

Fabrication, falsification, or intentional misrepresentation of research findings is strictly prohibited.

Authorship

Authorship should be limited to individuals who have made substantial intellectual contributions to the work.

All authors should:

- Participate in preparing the manuscript.
- Approve the final version.
- Accept responsibility for the published work.

Guest, honorary, or ghost authorship is not acceptable.
